## Statewide Directional Signing Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes

May 19, 2003

## **Goal & Vision for Sign Programs/Integrated Directional Signing Programs (IDSP)**

Ray indicated that the goal is to streamline the program and the vision is a One Stop Shop - TODS, Logo and Supplemental Signing Program. Establishing the Request for Proposal (RFP) will facilitate streamlining the program.

### Request for Proposals (RFP)

The draft RFP was handed out to the committee for their review. Ray explained the overlap of TODS with Logo. We don't expect major or dramatic changes to Logo; it's just rolling the TODS Program into the

program. The TODS Program is on primaries and not the interstate. The Logo Program, including Attractions, is on the interstates. He also expressed that there are going to be a lot of questions.

Mauris explained the RFP to the committee by giving them an overview of what it entails and advised them that the Contractor will recommend the cost under the RFP, as well as proposing criteria. General Motor Service's signs are currently paid for by VDOT. Supplemental Signs are more specific and general informational signs are relatively limited in use. Mauris expressed that there are back logs because of staffing resources and that requests are still coming in.

### **Discussions/Questions/Answers**

When is the proposed implementation of the ISDSP? January 2004

Who's qualified to be on the program? The Contractor will determine the criteria in conjunction with VDOT.

When does the current Virginia Logo contract expire? Expires September 30, 2005. VDOT does not intend to cancel Virginia Logo's existing contract.

Why is Virginia Logos not a part of these meetings? Not intended to reflect badly on them, only trying to avoid perceptions that they have inside control of the RFP.

Would additional panels be added to the Logo? Additional panels wouldn't be added to the Logo signs.

What is attraction? Attractions can take many different forms and will be determined as part of the contract.

Are there other states under this program? We believe Virginia will be the first State to bring all directional signing programs under one umbrella.

What's the selection process of the Contractor? The RFP process was explained.

Looking for GM panel signs for truckers (Truck Service's Signs). The truckers need more of a notification in advance to exiting.

Over looked Truck Stop Association for previous meeting. We have taken the liberty of inviting them to the Committee.

A suggestion was made that the contractor seek input from affected parties. The selected contractor will be present at future meetings.
