



## STUDY UPDATE

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) issued the Notice of Availability (NOA) for the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) on July 28, 2023. The DEIS contains information on the potential effects of the alternatives considered to natural resources, land use, socioeconomics and the human environment, minority and low-income communities, historic resources, noise, air quality and traffic.

The public has the opportunity to participate in a virtual and inperson public hearing, as well as provide comments during the 45-day comment period.

In coordination with federal, state and local agencies, VDOT will document and consider all comments received and, if necessary, conduct further analyses. The FHWA will then issue a Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) that will include responses to all substantive comments, and the study will conclude when FHWA issues the Record of Decision.
